



The Robbinsville Township Police Department, in conjunction with the Robbinsville Municipal Alliance for the Prevention of Substance Abuse (R*MAPSA) has been accepting unused or excess medications for over two years now. This has proven to be a very successful program. Residents may visit the Police Department at any time to drop off any unused or excess medications anonymously...24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year with no questions asked. The drop box is located in the Robbinsville Twp. Police Dept. lobby.

We are now going to expand our reach and come to the Senior Center the first Monday of every month from 11:30 am to 12:15pm.

This will allow seniors to bring their unwanted or excess medications with them to a function they may already be attending or just to make the process easier for them.

Let's all work together to insure unused and unwanted or expired medications are properly disposed of.

NOTE: Liquids and syringes cannot be dropped in the drop box.
